The plaintiff, Isaac Scott, states that he is the owner of one Mandolan cut off Saw, 28 inches in diameter, of the actual value of \$20.00. He states that the defendant, J.W. McCrae, has possession of said property and refuses to deliver same to this plaintiff, although he has demanded that same be returned to him. He states that said defendant has had possession of said saw since about the first day of Oct. 1914, and has had possession and used same since said date, and that by reason thereof, this plaintiff has been damaged in the sum of ~~\$10.00~~^{40.00} for the detention thereof.

The plaintiff states that he is the owner of said property and he is entitled to the immediate possession of same, that the property is wrongfully detained by the defendant and it has not been taken for a tax or fine against the plaintiff or by any order of the Court against him, nor seized under an execution, tax warrant or attachment against this property.

Wherfore the plaintiff prays for a judgement against the defendant, for the possession of said saw and for judgement for \$10.00 damages and cost and all proper relief.
