The defendant Ezra Curtsinger having been duly summoned and failing to answer, it is adjudged by the Court that the plaintiff The J.C. Vanarsdall Company recover of the defendant Ezra Curtsinger the sum of \$139.53 with six per cent per annum interest thereon from the 20th day of March, 1920, till paid and his costs herein. It is further adjudged that to secure said debt the plaintiff has a lien on the following personal property in Mercer County, Kentucky, Viz:

One bay mare about 16 hands high, small star in forehead, 7 years old; one brown mare about 15 hands high, bald face, five years old, one full leather top buggy, Allbrand make, rubber tire and black in color and that so much of said property as may be necessary to satisfy said debt, interest and costs be sold for that purpose and S.W. Kennedy, Sheriff of Mercer County, Ky., is hereby appointed as Special Commissioner of this Court to execute this Judgment and he will make said sale at the Court House Door in Harrodsburg, Ky., on the first day of some County or Circuit Court held for Mercer County, Kentucky at public outcry to the highest and best bidder on a credit of three months.

He will take from the purchasers bond with good and sufficient surety, payable to himself and bearing six per cent interest thereon from date until paid. Before making said sale he will advertise the time, terms and place thereof and the sum for which it is to be made together with a description of the property to be sold by written or printed notices to be posted up, one at the Court House Door in Harrodsburg, Kentucky and at three other public places in Mercer County, Kentucky, for at least fifteen days just prior to the day of sale and he will also advertise said sale in some newspaper published in Mercer County, Kentucky, in three consecutive issues of said paper prior to the day of sale and he will report his actions herein to this Court and said Commissioner is hereby awarded a writ of possession for the above named property.
