**The Commonwealth of Kentucky,**

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that .....

The arresting officer may take bail in the sum of \$ 25.00 for the appearance  
of defendant for trial on a day to be fixed by said officer in the bail bond according to law.
