The Plaintiffs state that the defendant by his promisory note dated Jan 4, 1921 agreed and promised to pay The Farmers Bank of Salvisa Ky the sum of \$145.00 120 days thereafter with interest from date until paid; that said note is long past due, is filed as a part hereof, and no part thereof has ever been paid; that said sum is just, due and owing; that plaintiffs believe they should have and recover the full sum of \$145.00 interest from Jan 4, 1921 and interest and costs; that the defendant has not sufficient property subject to execution to satisfy and pay the amount of said indebtedness interest and costs and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found; that the defendant is about to sell, convey conceal or otherwise dispose of his property with the fraudulent intent to cheat hinder and delay his creditors including the plaintiff.

Wherefore plaintiffs pray judgment for \$145.00 with 6% interest from Jan 4, 1921 until paid and costs; for a general order of attachment against the defendant's property and generally for costs and all proper relief.
