

Mercer County Court.

Chas.P.Thompson, and Others

Judgment.

Upon Petition.

The petitioners herein having filed their petition for a division of the lands described in the petition on May 29th, 1913 and A.F. Leonard, J.N. Dean and Isaac Hendron having by this court been appointed commissioners to meet on the said land and to make an equitable division thereof in accordance with the rights of the parties in interest, and the said commissioners after first being duly sworn, having met on the premises on June 4th 1913 and having divided said land between Chas.P. Thompson and the heirs of Etta McCrosky, and the said commissioners having filed their report of division of said land July 7th, 1913, and no exceptions having been filed to the said report of division, and this case being submitted on the pleadings and exhibits, it is adjouged that the said report of division of the said commissioners be and the same is hereby confirmed and that division of the said lands be made in accordance therewith, to wit that there be allotted to Chas.P. Thompson two thirds of 45 acres bounded as follows, Beginning at a stone in Jackson Pike corner to McCrosky, thence with center of pike N 85°W 5.60 chns., thence S 77½°W 1.50 chns, thence S 44°W 4 4.08 chns., thence S 75° W 2.10 chains, thence leaving the pike S 26° W 1.88 chains to a stone corner to Thompson, thence S 54°E 31.01 chains to a stone corner to McCrosky, thence N 44½E 16 chains to center of pike, thence with center of same N 54°W 20.26 chains to the Beginning, containing 45 acres more or less, and that there be allotted to the heirs of Etta McCrosky decd, to-wit Henry Thompson McCrosky, Fay Beckham McCrosky, and Jeanetta Lillian McCrosky the following described tract of land, Beginning at a stone corner to Chas.P. Thompson in Grimes line, thence N 44 ½°E 16 chains to a stone at the corner forks of the pike, thence with the center of the Jackson pike N 54°W 16.56 chains to corner to C.P. Thompson, thence leaving the pike S 44½°W 16 chains to stone corner to C.P. Thompson, thence S 54°E 16.56 chains the the Beginning containing 26 acres, being one third in value according to quantity and quality. It is further ordered and adjouged that W.W. Stephenson is hereby appointed commissioner of this court to make to the said parties deeds conveying the said tracts of land in accordance with the said allotment
