The plaintiff, Mrs. Bettie Green, states that the defendant, Mrs. Eva Farris, has in her possession goods and merchandise belonging to this plaintiff and which she is wrongfully detaining and which she refuses to deliver to this plaintiff though she has been requested so to do at her residence of the description and value as follows: One black iron bedstead and springs of the value of \$25.00; one dining table, square with four legs and of very dark color and an extension table of the value of \$10.00; 6 chairs- 4 of which have cane bottoms-- and 2 of which have paper bottoms, and of the value of \$2.00 each, or \$12.00 for all; one rocking chair, solid wood, of the value of \$5.00; one linoleum, blue checked, containing 11 yards and of the value of \$5.00. She says that these goods as above described were not taken for under an attachment, execution, or distress and were not seized under an order or judgment of a court and not taken for a tax or a fine against this plaintiff and that same are being illegally and wrongfully detained and kept by defendant in damages to this plaintiff in the sum of \$10.00. She says that the cause of action herein has accrued within the last year.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for an order of delivery for said articles and for a delivery of same under said order if delivery is possible and if not she prays for a judgment for the value of said articles and for \$10.00 damages for their wrongful detention amounting in all to the sum of \$65.00; she prays for her costs and all relief-
