

Plintiff says that his claim is just due and unpaid; that he ought as he verily believes, to recover the sum of 54,83; that the defendant has ~~now~~ not enough property in the ~~same~~ subject to execution, to satisfy the demands of plaintiff and plaintiff's ~~other~~ other creditors; that his claim will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found.

Wherefore the plaintiff, prays a judgment against the defendant for the sum of \$54,83 with interest from date, for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant, for his cost and for all other relief to which he may be entitled.
