The plffs. Harrodsburg Percheron Draft Horse Co., states that it is a Company organized for the purpose of owning and standing a percheron stallion.

The plff. states that in 1914 it licensed and advertised it's stallion, Dixon, standing ^{at} Robert Forsythe's ^{farm} to make the season of 1914 at \$15.00 to insure a living colt; said Company reserved a lien on said colt until season money is paid in full.

On May 19th, 1914 the deft, Dick Cornelius bred a blind bay mare to said horse, Dixon; the plff. states that in 1915 said plff's blind bay mare foaled a bay horse colt, with white star in it's forehead, and that said colt is the get of said plff. Stallion Dixon.

The plff. states that the season for the said colt is long since past due and that no part thereof has been paid and that said Cornelius has refused to pay said season.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays for a judgment against said deft. and that he be given a lien upon the colt for the season \$15.00 and his costs and all proper relief.
