

a balance of \$60.00 still due and owing. Plaintiff further states that it has made demand for the payment of the balance of \$60.00 of the defendants, but that said defendants refused and still do refuse to pay same.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendants, G. P. Chinn and G. M. Chinn, partners, trading as The Riverside Inn, in the sum of \$60.00 with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from June 1, 1924 until paid; for its costs herein expended and all proper relief.
