The plaintiff, Claunch & Hatchell, say that they are a firm composed of M.G. Claunch and Albert Hatchell and that they are engaged in the general store business; that they sold and delivered to the defendant at her special instance and request goods and merchandise of the value of \$97.76 cents for which she agreed and promised to pay them therefor that amount.

They say that said debt is due and unpaid and that they ought to recover said amount.

They this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due and unpaid though payment has been repeatedly demanded, but refused; that she has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$97.76 and all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and for all relief.
