Revenue Agent for the State at Large, states that the defendant,

was on the first day of September, 1901, 1910, 1911, 1912, and 1913, a resident of

County, Kentucky; and on each of the aforesaid dates the

defendant was the owner of personal property as follows, to-wit:

On September 1, 1901, one-half of notes of T. J. Odor \$3900.00, V. T. Sweeney \$300.00, C. W. Stollard \$250.00, balanced of notes and cash acknowledged \$1600.00.

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00.

On September 1, 1911, one-half of notes of T. J. Odor \$3925.00, Geo. Burr \$2,000.00, V. T. Sweeney \$300.00, C. W. Stollard \$250.00, Notes and cash acknowledged \$500.00.

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00.

On September 1, 1912, one-half of notes of T. J. Odor \$3950.00, V. T. Sweeney \$300.00, W. C. Sweeney \$166.00, A. T. Greacher \$150.00, C. W. Stollard \$250.00, Clever Sweeney \$1500.00, George Burr \$2000.00, Cash and notes acknowledged \$800.00.

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00.

On September 1, 1913, one-half of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00.

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$

and all of said property was wholly omitted from assessment for taxation for State and County purposes

with the Assessor of County or any other assessing officer or assessing board of said County or of the State of Kentucky, on each of the dates aforesaid, and that the tax thereon is now delinquent.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays judgment that said property be assessed against the defendant herein as of each of the dates aforesaid and that he be adjudged liable to the Commonwealth of Kentucky and County for the tax on said property for the years 1901, 1911, 1912, and 1913, together with the statutory penalty of twenty (20%) per centum due thereon. Plaintiff prays for its costs herein expended and for all further and proper relief.
