The plaintiff Kyle R. Teater says that the defendant Willie Armstrong is indebted to him in the sum of \$58,50, for goods, wares, and merchandise which the plaintiff sold and delivered to the defendant at his special instance and request and for which he agreed to pay plaintiff; he says that account is just due and unpaid and that he has demanded payment of same, but defendant has failed and refuse to pay same and that he believes he should recover the said amount from the defendant with interest and costs; he says that the defendant has no property in this State or not enough thereof to satisfy the demand of plaintiff and demand of defendants creditors and that the collection of his claim will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant Willie Armstrong for the said sum of \$58,50 with 6% interest thereon from the first day of January, 1921, till paid, for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and that the Bufley Tobacco Growers Co-operative Association be summoned as Garnishee herein, for his costs and for whatever relief he may appear entitled to.
