He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same and that this is an action for money due upon a contract.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$53.00 and all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant a summons against the L.E.Myer's Co., as garnishee- He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled-
