ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN C. S. VANARSDALL, PARTY OF FIRST PART, AND JAMES REDFORD, PARTY OF SECOND PART.

Party of first part has this day rented to party of second part his stable on Broadway in Harrodsburg, Ky., for one year from January 1st, 1917, for twenty dollars (\$20.00) a month, payable on the first day of each month in advance. For the repairs necessary on said stable, inside or outside, party of first part agrees to furnish the material and party of the second part agrees to furnish the tools and do the work free of charge.

Party of second part rents the stable for one year with the privilege of two years, and if he decides not to rent it the second year he is to give party of the first part three (3) months notice in advance; and if party of first part should sell the stable and want possession, he is to give party of second part three (3) months notice.
