The plaintiff, Harrodsburg Implement Co states that the defendant Addison B King by his promissory note which he executed and delivered to the plaintiff Oct 24th 1923, agreed and promised on the 1st day of Jany 1924 to pay to the plaintiff \$51.60, with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been paid. Copy of note is filed herewith.

It says that the said ~~account~~ debt is just and that the plaintiff ought to recover the said amount sued for, and that the defendant has not sufficient property in this State to satisfy the plaintiff's demand and that its demand will be endangered by delay and a return of no property found.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for the said sum of \$51.60 with interest thereon from Jany 1st 1924, for a general order of attachment including garnishee against the defendant, and for its cost and for all proper relief.
