Plaintiff, Harrodsburg Ice & Produce Company says that it is a corporation organized under and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of Kentucky and as such has the power to contract and be contracted with and to sue and be sued and was so impowered at all times herein mentioned.

Plaintiff says that the defendant is indebted to it in the sum of \$ 54.90 subject to a credit of seventy-five (75¢) leaving a balance of \$ 54.15; that said indebtedness is for goods wares and merchandise sold and delivered this defendant at his special instance and request and for which said defendant at the time promised and agreed to pay. It says that payment has been often demanded but that defendant has failed and refused and still failes and refuses to pay the same or any part thereof and that the whole fo said account or amount subject to the credit above setout is due and unpaid.

Wherefore plaintiff prays judgment in the sum of \$ 54.15 with interest from October 1st 1927 until paid; for its costs herein and all proper relief both legal and equitable.
