Warrant of Arrest.

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Speed Royalty

has committed the offense of
uttering and delivering to Ingram's Garage a check for \$4⁰⁰
on the Citizens Bank of Burgettsville, ^{Mar 20 1919} without having in said
Bank funds sufficient to meet said check

in the County of Mercer, the 16 day of June 1919.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said *Speed Royalty*
and bring *him* before me to be dealt with according to law.

Given under my hand as Judge of the Mercer County Court this 10th day
of July 1919. *J. W. Daenfert* Judge of Mercer County Court.

Summon *James P. Ingram and Geo. W. Hale* as witness for plaintiff and

as witness for defendant.

The arresting officer may take bail in the sum of \$ 100⁰⁰ for the appearance
of defendant for trial on a day to be fixed by said officer in the bail bond according to law.
