

Warrant of Arrest.

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Owen Card

has committed the offense of

Breach of the Peace by assaulting and  
abusing his wife — Card,

in the County of Mercer, the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August, 1918.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Owen Card  
and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.

Given under my hand as Judge of the Mercer County Court this 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of August, 1918 J.W. Doompson

Summon Mrs. Owen Card

as witness for plaintiff and

for Defendant.

The arresting officer may take bail in the sum of \$100.00 for the appearance  
of defendant for trial on a day to be fixed by said officer in the bail bond according to law.
