The plaintiff, the Geo. Bohon Co, for answer to the plaintiff's statement herein and by way of cross petition by way of its co-defendant, R.W. Tewmey, states that it has in its possession a certain buggy, which was bought by the defendant, R.W. Tewmey from it and for which he agreed to pay the sum of \$75.00. He states that it was part of said agreement that the said Tewmey was to allow the buggy to remain in the possession of this defendant until paid, and it it was to have a lien on said buggy until the entire purchase money was paid. Wherefore it prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$35.00 and its cost herein and for an order directing a sale of said buggy for the purpose of satisfying said indebtedness and cost.
