to the Sheriff of Mercer County;-

Whereas L. M. VanArsdale has made complaint to me that Grace B. Gordon and J. C. Gordon, did on the day of July 1919 forcibly detain from him a store house and lot on the east side of Main street in Harrodsburg, Ky, known as Maryland Cafe, and which the said Gordons tenants of said Vanarsdale now hold against him; you are therefore commanded to summon the said Gordons to appear before me at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky on the 10th day of July 1919 at 10 o'clock a.m. at which time and place inquiry will be made and trial had as to the said forcibly entry, and you will give said Grace B. Gordon and J. C. Gordon at least three days notice of the time and place of said hearing and have then and there this writ.

The ~~xxxx~~ property is bounded on the North by the store of Mollie Dedman, on the East by Greenville street, south by Post Office building and West by Main Street.
