Plaintiff, Cogar Grain Coal & Feed Company states that the defendant, Luther Lawerson is indebted to it in the sum of \$18.22 on account, that said account is just, due and unpaid, and though demand has been made upon defendant he has failed and refused, and still fails and refuses to pay said account or any part of same.
