In the matter of Armpstead Patterson Will

This day came State Bank & Trust Co of Harrodsburg, Ky and produced into Court a paper dated the 23 day of May 1918 ~~xxxxxx~~ with three codicils thereto dated respectively, Nov. 25, 1919, Octo 25, 1920 and Oct 17, 1921, purporting to be the will of Armpstead Patterson known as A. Patterson and offered said will for probate, and said will and each of said codicils were proved by the oaths of Geo. W. Edwards and C. E. Rankin and the Court <sup>paper</sup> being advised adjudges that said ~~will~~ with said three codicils is the true last will and ~~xxxx~~ testament of Armpstead Patterson, known also as A. Patterson, and adjudges that it be recorded as such.

Thereupon came State Bank & Trust Co of Harrodsburg, Ky nominated executor, accepted the trust, took the oath and executed bond as such in the penal sum of \$40,000.00 with its capital stock as surety as required by law.
