W.K.Cardwell Restoration Matter.

McH.29,1921.

A jury having been called upon the affidavit of Dr.J.B.Robards to the effect that W.K.Cardwell had been restored to his proper senses, to inquire into the facts, the evidence being heard and verdict returned into court declaring the said Cardwell restored to his proper senses, it is adjudged by the court that the said W.K. Cardwell is now restored to his proper senses, and is capable of managing, controlling and disposing of his estate, and that of others intrusted to his care and control by deed, will or other legal transfer; competent to transact any business, make contracts, sue and be sued, and do and perform all other acts common to persons of sound mind. It is further ordered that all moneie, property, real and personal, bonds, notes, and other evidences of debt, placed in the hands of his committee, First National Bank of Harrodsburg, Ky., under former orders of this court, be restored to him without delay, less legal charges against the same incurred by his committee from Feb. 24 to this date. Said committee is now released from further liability under its trust, and is finally discharged.
