The plaintiff, G.T.Litterel, states that the defendant Allen Darland, is indebted to him in the sum of \$60.00 with interest thereon from the last day of February 1824 until paid.

He says that the said Allen Darland rented from this plaintiff a house and lot in Cornishville, Ky. at the rate of \$15.00 per month and that he has not paid sent rent for a period of four month and that said rent amounts to the sum of \$60.00 and that he demanded payment of same in February 1924 and said payment was refused and he has failed and refused to pay same.

He says that defendant is a non-resident of the State of Kentucky and that he has no property in this State subject to execution sufficient to pay same except a wagon and car and that he is preparing to remove them from this State not leaving enough property therein to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same and that this is an action for money due upon a contract and that it is just due and unpaid.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$60.00 and interest thereon from the last day of Feb- 1924 until paid and all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled-including a general order of attachment against the defendant's property.
