Plaintiff says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid; that they ought to recover thereon the sum of \$37.15; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$37.15 and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant including a return against the Turkey Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association as guaranties.

He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled.
