The affiant, Leo McCoy says that he is in control of and has possession of the Walter Martin farm in Mercer County Kentucky ; that on or about the 20th., day of May 1929 one Will Graham placed on said farm and while this affiant was in possession two head of five year old horses and again on or about the 15th., day of June 1929 the said Graham placed on said farm another horse about five years of age ; that during said period of time said horses have been pastured by this affiant and have been regularly and continuously fed and pastured and provided with suitable provinder.

He says that \$200.00 is a reasonable and proper compensation for the keeping and pasturage of said horses and that notwithstanding the demand for payment of said amount the said Graham has failed and refused to pay said affiant any part of said compensation.

Wherefore affiant asks for a distress warrant against the property referred to herein and that said property be seized for the amount due , to wit, \$200.00 and for his costs herein expended.
