The plaintiff, W. L. Gordon, without waiving his rights to plead orally herein, for statement of his cause of action says that on December 11, 1926, by written contract with the defendants, The Herald, a newspaper published in Harrodsburg, Ky., of which D. M. Hutton is owner and editor, he agreed to furnish the Herald with articles weekly at fifty cents per week, payable semi-monthly; that he furnished articles from December 31, 1926 to November 30, 1927, amounting in all to twenty-five dollars and that the said articles bore interest from date when due to amount to the sum of one dollar, making his total claim twenty-six dollars; that by said contract the defendant had the right, on fifteen days notice, to cease to take said articles but that it failed to give this plaintiff any notice and that the articles were sent to it as aforesaid and received by it.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays for judgment in the sum of twenty-six dollars (\$26.00), for costs of this action and for all other proper relief.
