Capt. George W. Kane Jr. states that at Davao on 30 March 1943 a Japanese guard killed one of the American Medical Corps enlisted men (Sgt McFee), who had been digging comotes along the north side of the compound outside of the fence. Witnesses to the killing are, Capt Robert K Whiteley, Capt MM Wohlfeld, Capt Eugene P Dale, Capt A C Schoftner, Lt Jack Hawkins, Lt Michael Dobervich and Capt Betram Bank. The Jap guard who did the killing was known as "Liver Lip". His real name might be known by Lt William Gentry, Major Thomas Powell, Jr or Lt Columbus Savage.
