Weaver Visits Harrodsburg

BRIG. GEN. JAMES R. N. WEAVER, Fremont, Ohio, captured along with members of Harrodsburg's famous tank company when the Japanese took Bataan, paid an impromptu visit to the Mercer County city Thursday night to tell families of the surviving members of the company what he could about the men.

He met members of the families of the 66 men from the Mercer County community who formed Company D, 192d Tank Battalion, Kentucky National Guard, which aided in the defense of Bataan and Corregidor, in the home of Mrs. Edwin "Skip" Rue, wife of Captain Rue, also captured on Bataan.

Capt. William Gentry, who was freed in the Philippines in January and came home several months ago, was present and helped General Weaver answer some of the questions asked.
