1. On or about 11 January 1942, I received a copy of a General Order issued by Headquarters Provisional Mank Group, UBAFFE, Bataan, P. I., which awarded me the Silver Star. This General Order was taken from me by the Japanese at Bilibid Prison, Marila, P. I. This General Order reed substantially as follows:

"lat It. William Centry, 0-404976, is swarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action.

"On Dec. 31, 1941 let Lt. William Gentry, 0-404976, Go. C 192nd Tank Bn, home address Harrodsburg, Ky, at Cabanatuan, Neuva Ecija, P. I. took under fire a unit of hostile tanks and after a running fight of over two hours culminated in the elimination of the unit and during the entire combat displaying gallantry in action
