This cause coming on to be heard on the pleadings and exhibits on file, and in appearing that the defendant, Carrie Preston, has been duly summoned herein and has failed to answer and it further appearing that the plaintiffs, Spear & Company, are entitled to the relief sought, it is adjudged that the said plaintiff recover of the said defendant the sum of Twenty Dollars and Forty-one cents, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum from May 15, 1915, until paid, and their costs herein expended. And it further appearing that the plaintiffs have a lien upon the property herein after described, to secure the payment of its said debt with interests and its costs herein, and which is adjudged a prior ~~lien~~ and superior lien upon

One Rotary Wahher; one Iron Bed (white); one Bed Spring; one Mattress; one Iron Bed Outfit; eight Lace Curtains; 21-1/2 yards of Ingrain Carpet, and 21-1/2 yards of Ingrain Carpet (2), now in the possession of the said defendant, in Mercer County, Kentucky;
