The plaintiff, E.L.Rogers & Son, state that in the year 1925, they sold and delivered to the defendant, U.S.Vandyke, goods and merchandise at his special instance and request, to the amount of \$73.72. He says that the said Vandyke has failed and refused to pay said amount which is still due and owing although he has been repeatedly requested to do so. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid and that he ought to recover thereon said amount. He says that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$73.72 and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant including a summons against the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association as garnishee. He prays for all relief to which he is entitled.
