

MERCER QUARTERLY COURT.

The plaintiff Edw. E. Rice, states that the defendant Robert Shearer, by a writing dated August 30, 1924, and which will be filed as a part hereof if required, executed and delivered to this plaintiff, promised and agreed to pay the sum of \$ 100.00 thirty days after date above mentioned with interest at 6% per annum. Plaintiff states that he has repeatedly demanded payment but that this defendant has failed and refused to pay and that he still fails and refuses to pay same or any part thereof and that the whole of said sum is now due and wholly unpaid.

Plaintiff says that this is an action for the recovery of money due upon a contract; that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand, and the collection of the demand will be endangered in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found.

Plaintiff says that this defendant is employed by the L. E. Myers Company .

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays judgment against defendant Robt. Shearer, for the sum of \$ 100.00 with interest at 6% from August 30, 1924; for a general order of attachment against defendant's property and that the L. E. Myers Company be required to answer as garnishee herein and for his costs herein and further relief he may be entitled.
