The Plaintiff Mishawaka Rubber and woolen Manufacturing Co, states that it is a corporation created and organized under the laws of the state of Ind, with power given it under its charter to contract and be contracted with sue and be sued in and under its corporate name.

Plaintiff says that the Deft. is now and was at the times mentioned herein a retail merchant doing business at Salvisa Mercer Co, KY.

Plff for cause of action herein says that on the 16th day of April 1924 the deft was then indebted to it for goods wares and merchandise sold and delivered to him in the sum of \$85.63 and upon said day drew his check payable to Plff upon the First National Bank of ~~Marshall~~ for said sum and plff have caused same to be presented to said bank for payment and said bank returned same unpaid and fails and refuses to pay same. Said Check is filed herewith as part hereof and no part has been paid,

Wherefore plff prays Judgt against the deft James Shuck for the sum of \$85.63 and 6% interest thereon from April 16th 1924 until paid and for cost and all proper and general relief.
