

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Charlie Curd, and Wm Sallee,

has committed the offense of
damaging property of L.C.Hurst, by said defendants Dogs
killing his chickens,

in the County of Mercer, the 4th day of September 1932.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Wm Sallee and Chas Curd,

and bring them before me to be dealt with according to law.
