

HOPE REVIVED LAFON LIVES

The possibility that Capt. Harry Lafon, of the -92nd Tank Battalion, reported killed on Bataan peninsula is still alive was revived today at Lincoln Memorial University, when information was received from his father, H. R. Lafon, of Harriman, Tenn., that he had received recent word from the War Department his son was only reported "missing in action."

The news that Captain Lafon was killed a few days before the fall of Bataan had become current at the college, and the announcement was made recently at Commencement, when the service flag was displayed, showing one gold star. The fraternity of which Harry was a member had a brief memorial service on Sunday, June 7.
