Plaintiff and affiant, Bishop Wash says that J. N. Sutherland is indebted to him in the sum of \$45.00, for professional services rendered his wife, at his request, and which were necessities for her, said services being rendered in March and April 1909, and an itemized account thereof is filed herewith as part hereof; that the defendant agreed and promised to pay said \$45 for said services but he has failed to do so though it has been past due for a long period of time.

He says that this is an action to recover said \$45.00, due on a contract to pay for said services and on his request that plff render said services; that he believes he should have and recover of the debt the just and full sum of \$45.00 with ~~25~~ 6% interest thereon from April 15, 1909 until paid, and his costs; that said sum is just, and past due and owing; that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy this indebtedness, and he is insolvent; that the collection of this claim will be endangered and delayed by the delay of obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore he prays judgment for \$45.00 with 6% interest thereon from April 15, 1909, and his costs and for orders of attachment and garnishment, against the defendant and that so much of his property be subjected as will satisfy said debt, interest and costs.
