Local Soldier Is Prisoner Of Japs



PVT. C. K. SADLER.

Pvt. Campbell K. Sadler, who was reported missing in action, months ago, is a prisoner of war of the Japanese government according to word received by his wife, Mrs. Fern Sadler, 411 Lucas avenue. The message stated that the young soldier was somewhere on the Philippine islands and was well and uninjured.

Pvt. Sadler enlisted with the National Guards in November, 1940, and was with the 192nd tank battalion. Every member of that battalion was reported missing or captured with Philippines. He has been overseas since October, 1941.
