

Letter Received From Serg. W. D. Sparrow

A letter has been received within the past few days from Sergeant William David Sparrow, son of Dr. and Mrs. W. D. Sparrow of Burgin, who is a prisoner of war of the Japanese at Osaka, Japan, to which camp he was removed from the Philippine Islands.

Although a prison camp form-card had been received earlier by the soldier's parents, the letter is the first the family has had from Sergeant Sparrow since before the fall of Bataan.

Morgan French, another Harrodsburg soldier, is in the same camp, and Sergeant Sparrow requested his parents to notify the French boy's family that he, too, is "all right."
