

Mr. and Mrs. Cliff French, Harrodsburg, were notified Wednesday by the War Department that the Japanese Government told the American Red Cross their son, Pvt. Edward T. French, was killed in action in the Philippine Islands April 22, 1942. The communication was the first news that Mr. and Mrs. French had heard of their son since the surrender of Bataan to the Japanese. Private French was one of Harrodsburg's sixty-six National Guardsmen who fought in the Philippines after the group was taken into the Regular Army.
