

Prayer Service Asked For Heroes Of Bataan

HARRODSBURG, Ky., April 12 (Special)—All churches in Harrodsburg and Mercer county are requested to have special prayers Sunday for the 66 Mercer county boys who two years ago this April were taken prisoners by the Japanese after the fall of Bataan.

Families of six of the Mercer men have been notified officially of their deaths. The dead are Sgt. Wallace Denny, Edward Trisler, Edward French, Oscar Dean, Fred Leonard and Elzie Anness. Those still unheard from are J. B. Scanlon, Willard Foster, Ben Devine, Herbert Steel and Yandell Terhune, according to the home service department of the Mercer Red Cross. Prisoner-of-war form cards have been received by the families of the others.

The request for prayers for the boys comes from J. D. Bussell, superintendent of the Sunday school at Hopewell Baptist church, whose son Vernon H. Bussell, is a prisoner of war of the Japanese government.
