The plaintiff, Albert Hatchell, states that the defendant, Ed Chumley, is indebted to him in the sum of \$50.30 for goods and merchandise sold and delivered to him at his special instance and request and that said account is long past due and unpaid though payment has been repeatedly demanded. An itemized statement will be filed herewith if requested. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid; that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and the demands of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$50.30 and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant including a summons against the Mercer Tobacco Warehouse Company as garnishee.
