due and owing to them by the

that there are no setoffs
or counterclaim against said
account. Wherefore, Plffs prays
judgement against the Dept. for
the sum of (\$103.75) with interest
thereon at the rate of six per
cent per annum from April 7,
1917., for their costs herein &
for all proper relief.
