Plaintiffs, J.W. Bland, W.B. Walker & Joe A. Walker, partners, doing business under the firm name of J.W. Bland Lumber Company state that the Defendant, James Long is justly indebted to them in the amount of \$71.21 for lumber, materials and other supplies sold and delivered to Defendant, an itemized statement of said account is filed herewith and made a part of this pleading; that Defendant promised to pay said account at the time of making the purchases of said materials and that since date of purchase he has reaffirmed his promise to pay, to wit on the 27th., day of December 1922, but as yet has failed and refused to pay said account or any part of the same.

Plaintiffs state that this is an action for money due on said account; they believe that they should have and recover the full amount of ## said account, together with costs of this suit; that Defendant has not sufficient property in this state to satisfy and pay said indebtedness nor has he sufficient property subject to execution to satisfy and pay the same and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.

Plaintiffs state that they believe or have reason to believe that the Garnishee, Cogar Grain Coal & Feed Company is indebted to the Defendant or has in its possession money or other property owing
