

to or belonging to the Defendant and that the same should be subjected to the demand of these plaintiffs.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs pray for judgment against Defendant for \$71.21, for the costs of this action and that Defendant's property or so much of it as necessary to meet the demands of these plaintiffs in the hands of the Garnishee, Cogar Grain Coal & Feed Company, be held for the payment of this debt and that the Garnishee, Cogar Grain Coal & Feed Company be required to answer this petition and to disclose what property or money or other articles of value it may have in its possession owing to or belonging to the Defendant, and Plaintiffs pray for all other relief to which they may seem to appear entitled.
