The plaintiff, Harrodsburg Implement Company, answering the intervening petition of W B Matherly, says . that the sale, if any made by the said King to the said Matherly, was a sale in bulk of the ~~his~~ stock of goods and implements of the said Bill King ; that the said sale was made without notice to this creditor or any creditor, that the purchaser, the intervening petitioner, failed to give notice and did not give notice to this creditor or any creditor of the said King, nor did he demand or received from said King a list of his creditors as required by law, and that said sale was fraudulent and void and that this plaintiff's attachment levied upon said goods , is superior to any claim of the intervening petitioner, and that the intervening petitioner, W B Matherly, by accepting said goods and using the same, has become indebted to this plaintiff in the sum owing it by the defendant King, and it makes this answer a petition against the said Matherly and prays judgment against him for its said debt, interest and cost, to wit for the sum of \$80.43 and the further sum of \$23.75 and interest thereon and the cost of this action.
