

This cause having been submitted to the Court upon the proof, pleadings and exhibits, and the Court being advised, adjudges that the plaintiff has manifestly a lien upon One Peerless 8 Cylinder Sedan automobile, one Hupp 4 Cylinder touring car, five passenger, one Page, 5 passenger, 6 cylinder automobile, to secure the payment of \$80.43; that by the answer of the defendant W B

Wetherly said cars are now in his possession, and it appearing that the defendant Bill King was on the 1st day of April 1926 duly warned of the pendency of this suit, and he having filed no answer,

it is now adjudged that said cars be sold to pay said debt of \$80.43 and the cost of this action.

T C Coleman, Sheriff of Mercer County is now made

this Court's commissioner to sell said cars, or so many thereof as is necessary to pay plaintiff's debt, interest and cost as aforesaid; and He will make said sale before the Court house door in Harrodsburg Ky ~~on a credit of three months~~ on Saturday August 21st 1926, at public auction to the highest and best bidder, taking bond therefor payable to him/with good security thereon.

It appearing that the debt for which said cars is sold is less than \$100. the said Commissioner will before making said sale, advertise the time, terms and place thereof, together with a description of the property to be sold by posting up notices thereof, written or printed, one at the Court House door, and three others in

conspicuous places in Mercer County. / He will report his acts to the next term of this Court. This case is continued for the trial of other issues.
