Comes now W.B.Matherly, intervening petitioner herein and states that on or about the ----- day of February, 1926, he purchased of the defendant, Bill King, the Peerless 8 Cylinder Sedan Automobile, the Hupp 4 Cylinder Touring Car Five Passenger, the Page 6 Cylinder Touring Car Five Passenger, upon which the plaintiff Harrodsburg Implement Company has a mortgage upon as setout in their petition.

He says that while he bought said cars and the entire stock of goods belonging to the said King ~~prior to~~ and without any knowledge of a lien being upon same that said lien is of record and is therefore superior to his claim herein, but that subject to said lien and plaintiff's rights thereunder the said entire property of the said King become his property by purchase including the mortgaged property sought to be subjected by plaintiff in this action; that when said property is sold and the mortgaged debt satisfied that the residue of said proceeds is the property of this intervener and that he is entitled to same by right of purchase as aforesaid subject to the lien herein and to the lien of George Merrimon asserted in another action.

Wherefore intervener, W.B.Matherly, ask to be made a party to this action and that this petition be taken as his answer and that said property described herein be adjudged to be the property of this intervener subjected to the rights of the plaintiff as aforesaid. He prays for his costs and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled- special, general and proper.
