vs Petition

D E Pulliam,

Deft

The Plaintiff, E H Gaither, states that the defendant D E Pulliam was during the 1926 a tenant on a farm owned by the plaintiff in Mercer County Ky, about one mile South of Salvise, and on the Louisville and Crab Orchard turnpike, known as the Tom McAfee farm.

He says that to enable the said Pulliam to cultivate and mature his crops on said farm and to live while so cultivating said crops and maturing the same he advanced to the said Pulliam One Hundred and Ten dollars and 85 cts (\$110.85) which was to be paid by the said Pulliam out of the crops on the said farm.

He says that after the sale of said crops the said Pulliam appropriated to his own use the proceeds thereof and neglected, failed and refused to pay to the plaintiff the amount so advanced to him by the plaintiff during said year, and he says that by reason thereof the said Pulliam is indebted to him in the sum of \$110.85 no part of which has ever been paid and he has for said advancements so made a first and prior lien upon all of the property of the said Pulliam on said place.

He says that the said Pulliam is about to sell, convey or otherwise dispose of his property with the fraudulent intent to cheat, hinder and delay the plaintiff in the collection of his demand : that he ~~said~~ has sold, conveyed and otherwise disposed of his property with such intent. That he has not sufficient property in this state subject to execution to satisfy plaintiffs
