The plaintiff, THE ENTERPRISE CO., states that it is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio and as such it is authorized to contract and be contracted with and to sue and be sued; the plaintiff states that the defendant, WP ROYALTY & WK ROYALTY are indebted to it in the sum of \$32.60 for goods, wares and merchandise sold and delivered to said defendants at their special instance and request by this plaintiff, as shown by itemized statement of account filed herewith as a part hereof marked "a". The plaintiff states that said account was due and payable on January 28th 1922 and that by the terms of its agreement with defendants, said account was to bear interest at the rate of six percent per annum from said date until paid, and that said account together with interest thereon as aforesaid is just due and unpaid, and now owing this plaintiff by these defendants.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for judgment against the defendants, WP ROYALTY & WK ROYALTY for the sum of \$32.60 with interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum from January 28th, 1922, and for its costs herein and for all proper relief.
